

Petition Calling for Improved 300 Series Buses

To the Honourable Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly in New South Wales. The petition of the people of New South Wales brings to the attention of the House:

During morning peak travel periods, the northbound 300 series buses on Baptist / Crown Street are often full when they reach Redfern / Surry Hills, and passengers are left waiting while full buses drive straight past them.

Passengers are forced to wait for another bus, or use other transport, adding to traffic congestion and pollution.

The problem will worsen with major residential redevelopment of former industrial sites to the south, as a result of the Government's urban consolidation policies. The Government must prepare now for the public transport needs of these new residents in inner city apartments.

The undersigned petitioners therefore ask that the Government:

- 1. Add express buses along the Eastern Distributor Tollway from southern suburbs to the city; and**
- 2. Expand the 300 series bus service to adequately serve the increasing inner city population, particularly in peak travel periods.**
